Porchlight envisions a community without homelessness. In keeping with our mission and values, we create innovative solutions, vibrant partnerships, and opportunities for those we serve.



# A WORD FROM OUR EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR

### Thank You for Your Support!

As we reflect on 2024, we are filled with gratitude for the incredible support we've received. This year brought exciting opportunities and unprecedented growth across our programs.

#### Shelter Expansion & Housing Assistance

Our men's emergency shelter has seen record-breaking attendance, reinforcing the urgent need for expanded services. We eagerly anticipate the opening of the new Bartillon shelter in early 2026. This state-of-the-art facility will feature two floors and smaller sleeping pods, offering a more dignified and supportive environment for up to 250 guests.

In 2025, our dedicated team will focus on helping shelter guests transition into permanent housing. However, we need your help to fund essential costs such as application fees, security deposits, and first month's rent. Operational funds cannot be used for these expenses, so

#### **Expanding Affordable Housing**

Affordable housing remains our core focus, with 375 units under our management. In 2024, we proudly added 12 one-bedroom apartments in east Madison, which will provide permanent homes for guests of Porchlight men's shelter. For over 35 years, we've been committed to offering stable housing, property management, and supportive services, ensuring a path toward lasting independence.

#### Employment & Job Training Success

Our Porchlight Products program, which provides employment opportunities for formerly homeless individuals with disabilities, continues to recover from pandemic-related challenges. Creative solutions, such as holiday gift basket sales and in-person events, helped boost revenue. We are thrilled to introduce a new product this year – apple crisp! # **MEN'S EMERGENCY DROP-IN SHELTER**

#### What We Do: Restoring Dignity Through Essential Services

Porchlight is dedicated to reducing homelessness in Dane County by offering targeted programs that address the unique needs of our community's most vulnerable. Our Men's Drop-In Shelter remains the sole emergency overnight facility for homeless men in the Madison area, providing not just a place to sleep, but also meals, showers, and access to case management services.

During the summer months, the shelter accommodates approximately 250 men each night, expanding to serve 300-350 individuals nightly during colder seasons. In 2024 alone, we provided 102,107 nights of emergency shelter to 1,750 men experiencing homelessness.

#### Our Impact: A Foundation for New Beginnings

After the passing of his father, Eric turned to alcohol and drugs to cope, eventually developing a cocaine addiction. This struggle led Eric and his son into homelessness. They managed to stay in hotels for about six weeks, but this was not a sustainable solution. With support from The Beacon and Porchlight staff, Eric received peer support and assistance with housing applications. In December, he moved into a new home in Madison with his son and their dog, Otis. Eric now takes pride in having a space where he can cook, clean, and pay rent.

Eric shared, "Being housed has empowered me. My physical and mental well-being is so much better. I'm stable and can relax, no longer always in fight or flight. It's like night and day!"

Through our "A Place to Call Home" fund, Porchlight assisted Eric with his security deposit and first month's rent. In 2024, this fund provided \$100,000 to help 109 individuals transition into stable housing.

## HOUSING PROGRAMS

# Housing That Heals: A Message to Our Supporters

As the largest nonprofit provider of low-income housing in Dane County, Porchlight offers a vital foundation for stability across our community. With 375 housing units spanning both transitional and permanent options, we're able to serve individuals and families in a variety of neighborhoods throughout Madison and the surrounding area.

Our transitional programs support residents for up to two years as they work toward permanent housing – whether that's with Porchlight or in the broader community. For those in permanent housing, Porchlight offers the security and stability of a home for as long as they choose to stay. Our housing options range from singleroom occupancy units for individuals to multi-family residences designed to support households of all sizes.

But housing is just the beginning. At Porchlight, we believe in addressing the root causes of homelessness, and that means offering more than just a roof overhead. Each resident is paired with a dedicated case manager who helps with job training, budgeting, life skills, and connections to vital community resources.

In 2024, Porchlight Housing served 464 individuals – men, women, and children – on their journey to stability.

#### **Our Impact: Families Thriving**

Michelle's story is one of strength, persistence, and the power of supportive housing. Nearly a decade ago, Michelle entered Porchlight's Permanent Family Housing program with five young children and a determination to build a better life.

# SAFE HAVEN

# Safe Haven: A Place of Hope and Healing

Safe Haven, located on Madison's east side, is a day shelter dedicated to supporting individuals experiencing homelessness and mental illness. Open daily from 8:30 a.m. to 6:00 p.m., eligible guests have access to meals, laundry, showers, and housingfocused case management. Our staff also provides crisis stabilization services to guests in acute distress. Additionally, Safe Haven offers 14 on-site permanent housing units for guests transitioning to stable living. In 2024, we served 748 shelter guests, each taking steps toward recovery and stability.

#### **Our Impact: A New Beginning**

In August 2023, Sean turned to Safe Haven after the devastating loss of his wife. Facing mental health challenges and homelessness, Sean had struggled to find consistent support. That changed when he connected with Safe Haven.

Recognizing Sean's resilience, our team assisted him in accessing psychiatric care and replacing vital documents, including his Social Security card. These steps paved the way for Sean to secure approval for Safe Haven housing.

By January 2025, Sean moved into his new home. He now enjoys peaceful

mornings, observing the local wildlife, and continues to receive support from his dedicated case workers. Reflecting on his journey, Sean shared, **"I am beyond grateful for the help I received here."**

Porchlight Products is a vocational rehabilitation program that provides disabled and formerly homeless individuals with meaningful employment opportunities. Through hands-on training in our commercial kitchen at the Thierer Road campus, employees gain essential job and life skills, fostering a sense of purpose, accomplishment, and self-esteem. They craft a variety of products, including jams, pickled items, and dry baking mixes, contributing to their journey toward stability and independence.

In 2024, we proudly introduced Apple Crisp to our beloved product line, showcasing the creativity and dedication of our team.

#### Our Impact: Celebrating Community Partnerships

This year, we honor Short Stack Eatery, a cherished local business that has exemplified community support and sustainability since its opening in 2014. Co-owners Alex Lindenmeyer and Sinead McHugh have been steadfast supporters of Porchlight Products, consistently featuring our items - such as Rhubarb Spread, Apple Butter, and Dilly Beans - in their menu offerings, including their renowned Bloody Marys.

#### Honoring the Legacy of DIGS: 25 Years of Preventing Evictions

After 25 impactful years, Porchlight's Dwelling Intervention Grants and Sustenance (DIGS) program concluded on December 31, 2024. From its inception, Program Manager Hasan Mohr led DIGS with unwavering dedication, and now embarks on a well-earned retirement. While Porchlight will not continue the program, its legacy endures through the thousands of families who remained stably housed thanks to your generous support.

In 2024 alone, DIGS provided counseling to 929 households and financial assistance to 627 households at risk of eviction. The program's flexible model – centered on "matching self-help" – enabled small, timely interventions that prevented housing crises. Collaborations with government entities, nonprofits, and faith-based communities, such as St. John's Lutheran, amplified its reach and effectiveness.

Innovative partnerships emerged, notably in Mazomanie and Black Earth, where church clusters pooled resources, ensuring immediate aid for residents in need. This model inspired similar initiatives in Mt. Horeb, exemplifying community-driven solutions to housing instability.

#### **Our Impact: Providing Hope**

In a 2003 *Wisconsin State Journal* article, Hasan was highlighted for his relentless commitment to aiding those in crisis, stating that "not one day or hour of the day goes by where he is not planning to help save somebody's life from disaster." **We extend our deepest** gratitude to Hasan for his years of service and wish him a restful and fulfilling retirement.




