
VISION

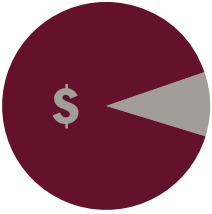

As we reflect on 2025, we are filled with gratitude for the incredible support we've received. This year brought exciting opportunities and unprecedented growth across our programs.

Shelter Expansion & Housing Assistance

Our men's emergency shelter has seen record-breaking attendance, reinforcing the urgent need for expanded services. We eagerly anticipate the opening of the new Bartillon shelter in mid-2026. This state-of-the-art facility will feature two floors and smaller sleeping pods, offering a more dignified and supportive environment for up to 250 guests.

In 2026, our dedicated team will focus on helping shelter guests transition into permanent housing. However, we need your help to fund essential costs such as application fees, security deposits, and first month's rent. Operational funds cannot be used for these expenses, so we are raising dedicated funds through our *A Place to Call Home* initiative. **If you'd like to contribute, you can donate securely here: →**



Expanding Affordable Housing

Affordable housing remains at the heart of our mission, with 330 units currently under our management. In 2025, we opened our new eight-story administrative building, which also

provides 70 efficiency apartments for residents. For more than 40 years, we have been committed to delivering stable housing, quality property management, and supportive services that create a pathway to lasting independence.

Employment & Job Training Success

Our *Porchlight Products* program provides meaningful employment opportunities for formerly homeless individuals with disabilities. Creative strategies, including holiday gift basket sales and expanded in-person events, have helped boost revenue. MEN'S EMERGENCY DROP-IN SHELTER

What We Do: Restoring Dignity Through Essential Services

Porchlight is dedicated to reducing homelessness in Dane County by offering targeted programs that address the unique needs of our community's most vulnerable. Our Men's Drop-In Shelter remains the sole emergency overnight facility for homeless men in the Madison area, providing not just a place to sleep, but also meals, showers, and access to case management services.

During the summer months, the shelter accommodates approximately 250 men each night, expanding to serve 300-350 individuals nightly during colder seasons. In 2025 alone, we provided 113,116 nights of emergency shelter to 1,766 men who were experiencing homelessness.

Our Impact: A Foundation for New Beginnings

CJ came to Porchlight after experiencing violence in his previous housing. When he defended himself, he was evicted and suddenly found himself without money, without

stability, and without a place to go. Entering shelter life was difficult – he often felt frustrated by the environment and the constant pressure of people asking him for things while everyone was trying to get by. At the same time, his health was declining.

Once very active, CJ now faced serious physical challenges that made daily life much harder.

With support from Porchlight, CJ was able to take a critical step forward.

Through assistance with his security deposit and first month's rent, along with consistent case management support, he secured stable housing.

That stability gave him the foundation he needed to begin focusing on his health and his future.

CJ worked hard to maintain his housing. **He committed to paying his rent, making more thoughtful choices in how he responded to others, and planning for long-term care.** With support, he was connected to in-home care services to help him manage his health while remaining independent in his own space.

Having a home brought CJ a sense of peace. It made him feel more comfortable – both mentally and physically – and gave him a place where he could truly rest.

Although CJ later passed away due to ongoing health issues, he remained housed until the end of his life. **Because of Porchlight, he had a place to call home** – a space where he could spend meaningful time with his grandchildren and live his final months with dignity.

HOUSING PROGRAMS

Housing That Heals: A Message to Our Supporters

As the largest nonprofit provider of low-income housing in Dane County, Porchlight offers a vital foundation for stability across our community. With 330 housing units spanning both transitional and permanent options, we're able to serve individuals and families in a variety of neighborhoods throughout Madison and the surrounding area.

Our transitional programs support residents for up to two years as they work toward permanent housing - whether that's with Porchlight or in the broader community. For those in permanent housing, Porchlight offers the security and stability of a home. Our housing options range from single-room occupancy units for individuals to multi-family residences designed to support households of all sizes.

But housing is just the beginning. **At Porchlight, we believe in addressing the root causes of homelessness**, and that means offering more than just a roof overhead. Each resident is paired with a dedicated case manager who helps with job training, budgeting, life skills, and connections to vital community resources.

In 2025, Porchlight Housing served 432 individuals - men, women, and children - on their journey to stability.

Our Impact: Families Thriving

In 2019, Kenny began working as a third-shift Shelter Assistant at Porchlight's overnight shelter while experiencing homelessness. By 2023, his perseverance paid off when a vacancy in one of Porchlight's family units opened up, aligning perfectly with his needs as he was mainly raising his son alone.

Despite the obstacles, Kenny stayed actively involved in his community. He coached youth football for over 12 years, a passion that eventually earned him a position as the JV football coach at Madison West High School, a role he held until 2024.

Today, **Kenny continues to mentor young athletes as a coach** with the Dane County Football League's Southside Raiders and the Madtown Elite Club's Pee-Wee Football team. His dedication, resilience, and commitment to giving back make him a genuine role model on and off the field.

Kenny's service ethic extends beyond coaching; he shares, "Saving lives and helping guests find permanent housing is the most rewarding part of my work at Porchlight," and adds, **"I appreciate Porchlight for believing in me and giving me a chance."**

SAFE HAVEN

Safe Haven: A Place of Hope and Healing

Safe Haven, located on Madison's east side, is a day shelter dedicated to supporting individuals experiencing homelessness and mental illness. Open daily from 8:30 am to 6:00 pm, eligible guests have access to meals, laundry, showers, and housing-focused case management. Our staff also provides crisis stabilization services to guests in acute distress. Additionally, Safe Haven offers 14 on-site permanent housing units for guests transitioning to stable living.

In 2025, we served 558 shelter guests, each taking steps toward recovery and stability.

Our Impact: A New Beginning

MJ first connected with Safe Haven in 2023 after being kicked out of his home at just 18 years old. With no financial support, no stable place to stay, and significant mental health challenges, he was trying to navigate adulthood without the resources

he needed to succeed. Daily life felt overwhelming, and he wasn't sure where to turn.

When MJ arrived at Safe Haven, he lacked direction – but not potential. **Staff worked consistently to build trust and show him that he wasn't alone.** Over time, that trust became the foundation for meaningful progress. The team supported MJ in accessing food stamps and health insurance, connected him with medical care, and helped him apply for Social Security disability benefits. Through this process, MJ was able to better understand his mental health diagnoses and ultimately secured a stable source of income through disability.

With that stability, **MJ reached a major milestone: he moved into his own Safe Haven apartment at the beginning of 2026.** Having a safe, consistent place to live has given him the opportunity to focus on his goals and well-being.

Today, MJ continues to work closely with Safe Haven staff. He is pursuing his GED, working toward getting his driver's license, and reconnecting with therapy to better manage his mental health. **He often shares how much the support has meant to him, referring to the Safe Haven team as his family and expressing deep gratitude for the role they've played in his journey.**

MJ's story is one of resilience, trust, and growth – made possible by stable housing, compassionate support, and the opportunity to build a future on his own terms.

PORCHLIGHT PRODUCTS

What We Do: Empowering Lives Through Porchlight Products

Porchlight Products is a vocational rehabilitation program that provides disabled and formerly homeless individuals with meaningful employment opportunities. Through hands-on training in our commercial kitchen at the Thierer Road campus, employees gain essential job and life skills, fostering a sense of purpose, accomplishment, and self-esteem. They craft a variety of products, including jams, pickled items, and

dry baking mixes, contributing to their journey toward stability and independence.

In 2025, we were able to expand the reach of Porchlight Products by partnering with several area organizations and businesses that featured our products for sale on their website, featured them in their own gift boxes or baskets, or bought in bulk to give to their clients, vendors, and employees.

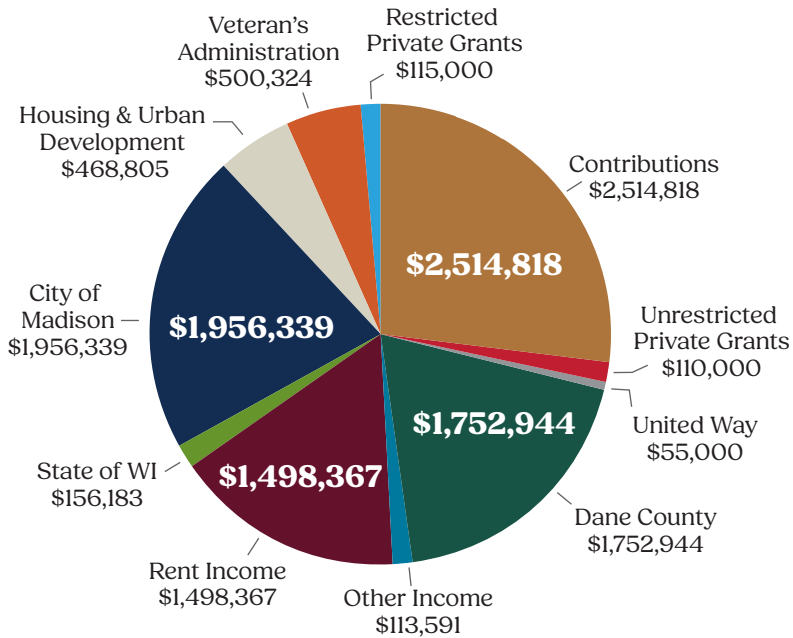

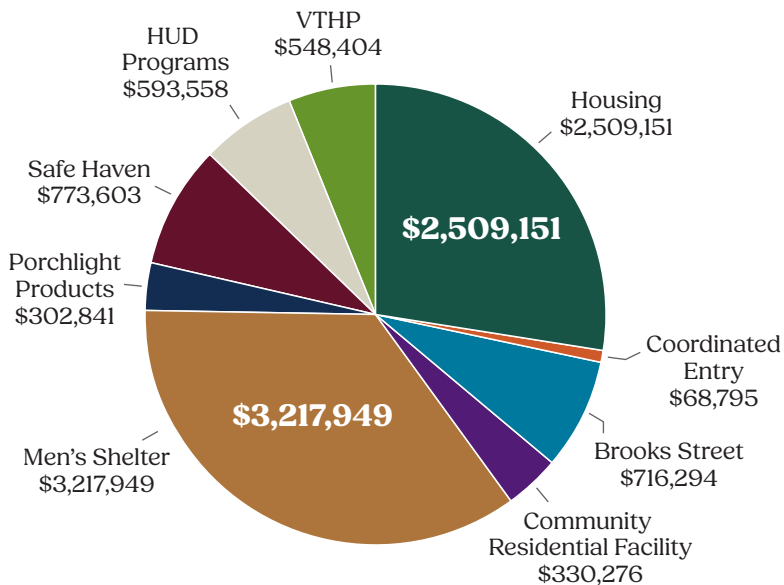

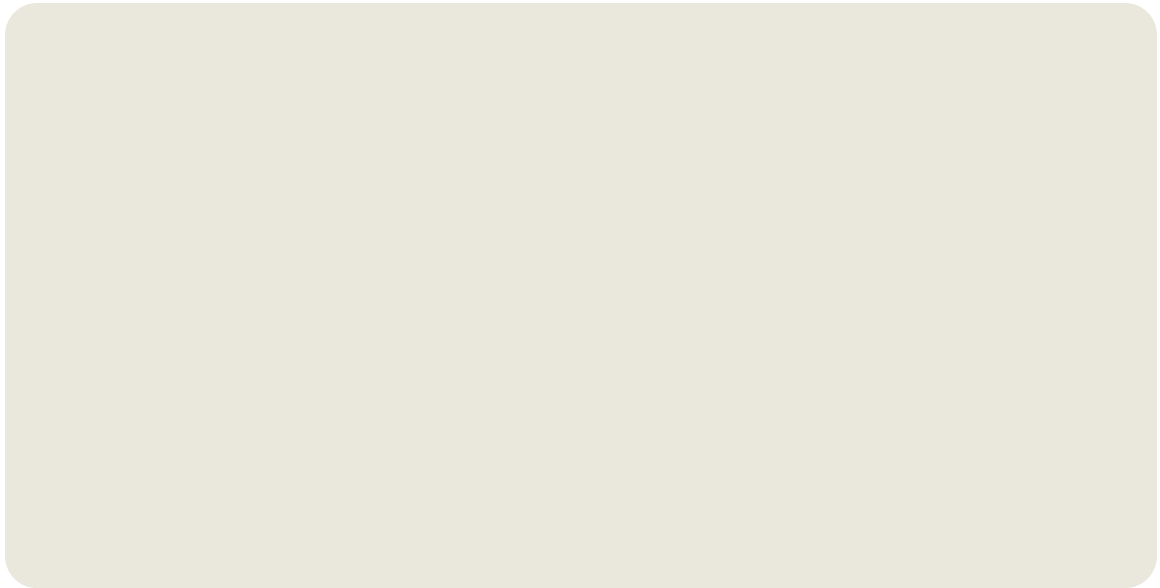
